IGF Jazz Course - Kings Place 21-22 July 2018

Nguyên Lê, assisted by Dario Cortese

On the 21st and 22nd of July 2018, IGF will offer you the unique opportunity to study with the acclaimed jazz musician Nguyên Lê. As a self-taught musician, Nguyên Lê delivers a very personal approach in his pedagogic works. In this workshop he will try to transmit the ways he discovered the science of music by himself.

As a Paris-born child of Vietnamese immigrants he grew up in a cross-cultural situation. Very early he became fascinated by non-western cultures which are part of Paris today's life. These influences are essential in Nguyên Lê's style, & he will show how to integrate the lessons of those cultures in the playing & the writing.

Nguyên Lê will be assisted by London based guitarist Dario Cortese, Head of Contemporary Styles of IGF.

Dario's will teach on the 21st and prepare the students on some of the topics and songs that will be studied on the 22nd. Nguyên Lê will take the whole of the 22nd.

Some of the topic that might be discussed:

- Modality & Polymodality
- Harmonization
- Ethnicization
- A different sense of time
