You will also meet a choir. They will sing to you when you enter the theatre and throughout the show.



You will sit in a circle in between the singers. The singers will sit on benches, you will sit on chairs or in your wheelchair.

Your support team will be encouraged to help you explore the sensory elements of the show.



You are free to move around the space. You are welcome to make as much noise as you need to.



In the show, you can leave the show whenever you want to.



At the end we will bow and say goodbye. You will leave through the door you came in.
